TEAM PARENT/COORDINATOR:

The Team Coordinator works closely with the coaches and supports the activities of the entire team, working closely with coaches and parents. The Team Coordinator organizes team activities. The Team Coordinator function is a critical one to the success of the team. Knowledge of softball skills or rules is not required.

You'll get basics of Team Sideline, as well as important season information.

An ASA background check IS required for this position.

This will ensure you receive integral league information, and will also allow you to communicate with the rest of our team on important dates and details.

SCOREKEEPERS:

It is extremely helpful to have several scorekeepers

An ASA background check IS NOT required for this position.

DUGOUT PARENT: (TEAM PARENT)

Helps keep players in the right batting order, helps the players to keep the dugout as organized as possible and cheering for their team. Also, helps the designated Jr. Dugout Girl and Bat Girl as needed.

An ASA background check IS required for this position.

*Being that the girls are old enough to have more responsibility, I will make a rotating schedule for the Jr. Dugout Girl and the Bat Girl. With the positions, I think it will give the players a sense of responsibility and leadership. It will also

help to keep them engaged during the game.

PRACTICE/PRE GAME ASSISTANTS:

Several that help “on the field” during practices and warming up the players before games. This way we can make the most of our practices by working with smaller groups of girls and also, less standing around time.

An ASA background check IS required for this position.

FIELD PREP

It is extremely helpful to have several field prep helpers

An ASA background check IS NOT required for this position.

*Other optional positions **

***JR. DUGOUT GIRL/rotating schedule among players**

Assists in making sure gear (bags, gloves, helmet and water bottles) are placed in it's appropriate spot, and leads in cheers for their team. Lastly, helps to remind the girls to pick up after themselves after the game...leaving the dugout clean for the next team.

***BAT GIRL/rotating schedule among players (needs to wear helmet during offense innings)**

Responsible for retrieving bats during our team's "at bat". Also, assists players in paying attention to their batting order and having their helmets on when it comes time to being on deck.

Who needs an ASA background check and why?

For the safety of our children, ASA requires that anyone on the field or in the dugout with the girls have a background check. Since scorekeepers are not on the field they do not require a background check. Yes, if you had this done last season as I did, it does need to be done again, every year.

What your daughter will need for games:

Navy Blue or Black Pants (coach will make this decision)

Glove

Non-metal cleats

Helmet with a face mask & chin strap attached (helmet/face-mask need to be NOCSAE approved).

If you are purchasing a bat, it must be ASA approved.

Water
